CAMP RULES

- * At Pfadfinderdorf Zellhof it is allowed to do what does not bother the neighbouring campsite and that which does not destroy things.
- * The Austrian Youth Protection laws are applicable to all camp participants and are posted in the kiosk. The same conditions apply to the Nature Conservation Laws Salzburg.
- * Please do not bring any alcohol with you. Beer and wine can be purchased at the camp store - Hard liquor like vodka, brandy etc.. are not allowed at Zellhof. Of course we have a variety of alcohol-free drinks.
- * Camp quiet times are from midnight until 7 in the morning.
All camp participants who are not accompanied by an adult chaperone must return to camp by midnight. Exceptions are overnight trips of two or more days - Please notify the team
- * Pfadfinderdorf Zellhof lies in the middle of a nature preserve.
Please do not make sump pits (we are connected to the sewer system) and no drainage canals (Dams are a better option). Fireplaces must be at least 15cm above ground level. Outside the campsite, please stay on walking paths and do not go through high grass,
- * Camping groups can take their drinking water from the Rossstall. Running hosepipes for water and electricity cables to the campsite is not possible.
- * Please do not go into the forest at sunrise and at sunset (Our wild animals wish to graze in peace), and please do not pick any rare or endangered flowers. Radios may only be played at a volume where the sound cannot be heard outside of the tent or room.
- * Pfadfinderdorf Zellhof lies directly on the Grabensee lake.
Please follow the swimming and boating rules which can be found in the kiosk.
Each group must provide for its swimmers a competent adult lifeguard.
All water activities are only permitted between 7 am - 8 pm.
Surfing, sailing boats and rafts are not permitted in the Grabensee.
- * Communal areas such as toilets, washing facilities, etc. are cleaned by the groups each day on a rota system, please bring your own cleaning liquids.
- * Rubbish separation: A recycling station can be found next to the kiosk.
Please separate out all rubbish at your campsite and avoid all unnecessary packages and wrapping.
- * Please keep the houses and the campsite tidy and turn them over in a clean state to the Zellhof team before departure.
- * Dogs are not allowed at Pfadfinderdorf Zellhof.
- * The Zellhof team consists of volunteer members of the Scouting movement, come from many different countries, and are always willing to assist you in your needs. The team is available to you at the kiosk.
