- 5) Look for the oldest bakery in Salzburg. What is the name of the nearby gate of the city?
- 6) Getreidegasse: What do the shields over the street mean? Draw one.
- 7) What is the Pferdeschwemme (horse pool) for ?
- 8) What is the address of the birth house of Mozart?
- 9) Alter Markt: which shop is in the smallest house in Salzburg?
- 10) Go on further to the weather station and describe the current weather conditions.
- 11) Residenzbrunner (Palace spring): which and how many stone animals are there on it
- 12) Which dates are on the entrance grill?
- 13) Catacombes (in St. Peter's cemetery): There are gravestones at the entrance : when was Helma Berta Müller born?
- 14) When was the monument to Mozart erected?
- 15) When was the Mozart bridge constructed?
- 16) Look for Steingasse 19 and draw the badge on the wooden door.
- 17) From Steingasse a flight of steps goes up the Kapuzinerberg (Kapuziner mountain). How many steps lead to the top ?Are there about: a) 150, b) 200 or c) more than 250?

End point is the bus stop in front of the Mirabell Palace (as the start point)
