

FREUNDSCHAFTSABZEICHEN FRIENDSHIP BADGE

If you would like to earn the Zellhof Friendship badge, you need to carry out eight different challenges which bring you into contact with as many of the groups staying on site as possible.

Such challenges can include:

- 1. Find out, from every group at Zellhof, the name of the group and where they come from (town, country, region).
- 2. Find two scouts from different groups and countries, exchange addresses and then try to find out as much as possible about their life (for example how their scout groups is organised, their family, their school system, job, where they live).
- 3. Organise something together with another scout such as a table tennis match, football game, campfire...
- 4. Collect information about the members of the Zellhof team. For example, ask their names, where they come from, where they live, which languages they speak...
- 5. Swap a neckerchief or badge with someone from another group.
- 6. Organise a joint activity with at least three other groups.
- 7 Invite someone from the Zellhof team for a meal
- 8. Translate the words "friendship", "scout" and "guide" into all languages which are spoken at Zellhof at the moment.
- 9. Exchange a recipe with someone from another group, and if possible from another country, and prepare it for your group or patrol.
